

World Cup in Jasna again

DEMÄNOVSKÁ DOLINA (10th of November 2011) – resort Jasna Nizke Tatry will organize the World Junior Championships in alpine disciplines in 2014. International Ski Federation (FIS) decided about this on its Monday's meeting in Schladming, Austria. The championship will take place in March 2014.

Year 2014 is still far away for Jasna from the view of everyday life in the resort, but considering that resort will host top juniors and it returns the World Championship to Jasna, it is a significant thing for Slovakia already now. Grand Prix of Damanovske Caves started the history of downhill skiing in Jasna in 1939

World Junior Championships in alpine disciplines will take place in Slovak ski resort Jasna Nizke Tatry in 2014. The changes in Jasna are behind this success. Big interest from the resort's side, investments already made and prepared affected this decision as well as personal meetings of Slovak ski association delegates and resort's delegates with FIS representatives. Jasna had already once the opportunity to organize very similar event, this was in year 1985.

The last top level event in Jasna took place in March 2011, when resort hosted European Cup race in women slalom. From the perspective of the next ski season, it is worth to mention, that resort will be again a center of prestigious women race of European importance. There will be European Cup in Super G and women super combination in February 2011.

There will be the World Cup in new discipline Slope Style only few days before this cup in Jasna. Jasna gradually returns Slovakia on the world skiing map.
